Itinerary

A clear breakdown of each day of the trip.

DAY 1

Visit Ashan Bazar, Kathmandu Durbar Square and Swyambunath

Dive into Kathmandu's vibrant heart on Day 1! Your adventure begins at 8:00 am with your friendly guide picking you up at your hotel. After a delicious breakfast, your first stop is the bustling Ashan Local Market. Immerse yourself in the sights, sounds, and smells as you witness the daily rhythm of local life.

In the afternoon, step back in time at Kathmandu Durbar Square, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Marvel at the intricate architecture of palaces, temples, and courtyards, whispering tales of Nepal's rich history.

As the sun dips low, ascend the hilltop Swyambhunath Temple, affectionately known as the Monkey Temple. Enjoy a delightful lunch of authentic Nepali cuisine while soaking in the panoramic views of the Kathmandu Valley. DAY 2

Visiting Patan and Khokana Village

As the afternoon light fades, embark on a short drive to Bhaktapur, another gem of the Kathmandu Valley, where your story continues for the night.

DAY 3

Explore Bhaktapur, and Chagunarayan Temple

Morning: Step into a time capsule in Bhaktapur, a living museum of ancient Newar tradition. Explore the enchanting Durbar Square, where intricate carvings and terracotta rooftops tell stories of a bygone era.

DAY 4

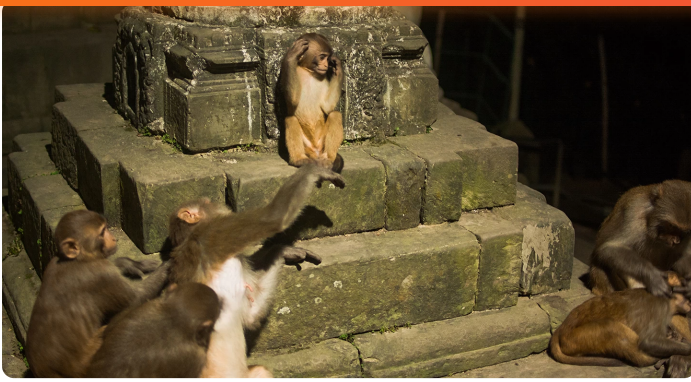
